Rappoport is taking one slice—Netanyahu's use of biblical language—and inflating it into an explanation for Israeli policy. That's a big leap, and it conveniently erases everything else conflict.

Start with the obvious question: if this were truly a "holy war to blot out Amalek," why has he behaved like one? Countries that wage extermination wars don't warn civilians, don't distinguish targets, and don't calibrate their response. You can criticize Israeli tactics—and plenty of —but the pattern doesn't match the thesis.

Yes, Benjamin Netanyahu has referenced biblical themes. Politicians do that—it rallies people. George W. Bush and Franklin D. Roosevelt both used moral, even quasi-religious framing. That doesn't mean policy is being run as scripture.

Rappoport also skips a major piece of context: Israel's historical memory. The shadow of the Holocaust isn't rhetorical decoration—it's foundational to how Israeli leaders think about threats. When Netanyahu says "never again," he's not necessarily invoking prophecy; he's invoking a doctrine: act early and decisively because waiting once proved catastrophic. You can disagree with how that doctrine is applied, but it's not mystical—it's strategic, even if you think it's overapplied.

Then there's Iran, which gets treated like a bystander here. It isn't. There's a long history of conflict and hostile rhetoric. Ignoring that while zeroing in on Netanyahu's language creates a lopsided narrative that feels persuasive only because half the picture is missing.

Now—separate issue—the globalist angle. If you believe there's a broader agenda, Netanyahu is some unique outlier. He operated in the same environment as dozens of leaders during COVID-19, many aligned with guidance from the World Health Organization. If that's your critique, it should be broadly—not selectively.

Conflating those two arguments—existential threat and global coordination—just muddies the waters. And singling out Netanyahu as some singular "prophet of holy war" while ignoring regional realities and how other leaders behaved starts to look less like analysis and more like a one-sided narrative with a target already chosen.
