The government of Israel officially declared the war against Iran “The War of Redemption”—thus cementing military and political policy as RELIGIOUS.

And Biblical.

This was Netanyahu’s doing.

It puts things on a whole different level.

Netanyahu sees himself carrying out Divine Command. Nothing less. Or, he’s promoting that image of himself as a con.

Either way, this turns dangerous into super-dangerous.

Netanyahu is using religion to invoke God and what God decrees in this war.

It goes back to the story of Amalek in the Bible. Netanyahu is saying, REMEMBER AMALEK.

Amalek was the leader of the Amalekite tribes who lived in the Negev desert, suddenly attacked Moses’ people, who were wandering in the desert after escape from Egypt.

The Amalekites were exceptionally cruel. They attacked the stragglers, the weak, the sick, the elderly, at the end of Moses' following, at the back of the line, away from the warriors.

The Torah, Exodus: Moses was told God would "utterly blot out the memory of Amalek from under heaven". In Deuteronomy: God told the Israelites to "remember what Amalek did to you," and "blot out the remembrance of Amalek."

Well, now that story is being applied to Israel's enemies. Iran is Amalek, and "blot out" means "destroy."

"The War of Redemption" means:

Israel isn't letting "the Amalekites" launch a surprise attack again.

This is one of the central myths Netanyahu is promoting.

I could reference other Biblical statements Netanyahu uses, but you get the idea.

He's all in on Holy War.

And no major news outlet in America is reporting and exploring and exposing this.

They've all clamped the lid down tight on it.

And there's more. A whole lot more.

Invoking Prophecies and Biblical interpretations and myths creates the entire narrative of what's at stake in the land called Israel. It's the land where stories clash.

It's the perfect set-up for the elite Globalists, who want massive destruction, for which they are intervening to bring about "a solution" loosely called the New World Order.

Think about it. The land of Israel is where Jesus lived and peached and was crucified and was resurrected. It's the land where the Prophet Muhammed stepped off a rock on his way to Heaven. It's the Promised Land, which God gave to His Chosen People, the Israelites. It's the land where End-Times Christians say the Final War will be sparked—ultimately leading to the Second Coming of Jesus.

The men who promote war and destruction have their perfect place, their perfect point.

And there is an endless supply of passions and religious devotion and delusion poured into...to keep the pot boiling.

This was essentially the first story I broke as a reporter in the early 1980s, which was published by LA Weekly. I found US end-times groups who were supporting right-wing Jews in Israel who wanted to attack and destroy the rock from which Muhammad stepped into heaven. They wanted Holy War. I found a US geologist who had used an advanced radar to scan the Dome of the Rock monument...and claimed that an ancient Temple of Israel was located directly under the Rock...and claimed that by Divine Command, the Rock had to be destroyed and the Temple raised again...as a consequence of Holy War.

Netanyahu is a recent example of one of those Prophets who's quite sure he's speaking on behalf of God.

He'll say he's fulfilling Isaiah: Beating swords into plowshares. But beating them takes a long, long time, and no sword can remain and so the destruction must be complete.

And without a clear plan, and on the basis of many blunders, and with his own sense of massive self-inflation and "great vision," Trump has gone along with this re-prophet named Netanyahu.
